



UPLB Centennial Loyalty Day and Grand Alumni Homecoming

PARADE GUIDELINES

1. **Assembly time is 6:00 am, October 10, 2019, at the Carillion area, AnSci-CVM complex. The parade will start at 7:00 am.**
2. A maximum of 100 participants per contingent is allowed.
3. The parade will consist of six main groups in sequence:
 - a. UPLB Management Committee
 - b. Alumni: Jubilarian and Non-Jubilarian Classes
 - c. UPLB Office of the Chancellor and Vice-Chancellor Offices
 - d. UPLB Colleges
 - e. Outside Institutions
 - f. Student Organizations

| 1. UPLB Management Committee | Front of Women's Dorm. This is led by the Chancellor followed by the Vice-Chancellors and other UPLB officials. |
| 2. Alumni (Jubilarians and Non-Jubilarians) | Golden Jubilarians (1969) and older classes will assemble in Front of ACCI Dorm/Thai Pavilion. Other jubilarian classes (1974, 1979, 1984, 1989, 1994, 1999, 2004, 2009, 2014, 2019) and non-jubilarian classes will assemble in front of Men's Dorm. |
| 3. UPLB Office of the Chancellor and Vice-Chancellor Offices | YMCA and CEC area |
| 4. UPLB Colleges and UP/UPLB units/organizations | CEC area and Manuel Roxas Ave. (near Alumni Plaza). Sequence: Alphabetical order of college (CAFS, CAS, CDC, CEAT, CEM, CFNR, CHE, CPAf, CVM, GS, SESAM) |
| 5. Outside Organizations | Mariano M. Mondoñedo Ave. (Animal Husbandry Arc, street going to DTRI) |
| 6. Student Organizations | Baseball field |

Participating groups are advised to find their markers in the area.

Each jubilarian contingent will be accompanied by UP Rural High School (UPRHS) students.

4. Parade route goes along Men's Dorm, turn at D. L. Umali Hall, then SU road and into the upper field.

5. The use of tarpaulins during the parade is discouraged; paper, cartolina, cloth and other biodegradable materials are suggested to be used consistent with the "Go Green" initiative of UPLB.

6. There will be no street presentations for this year's celebration.

7. The 11 UPLB Colleges are required to have a float. The design of the float must be aligned with this year's theme "UP Los Baños: Patuloy na Tumutugon sa Hamon ng Bayan."

8. Contingents from UPLB are expected to stay at the upper field (graduation area) for the announcement of the float competition winners, games and other surprises. Contingents from institutions outside UPLB are also encouraged to stay.

9. Vehicle parking will be on a first-come-first-served basis. The parking areas at the UPLB Graduate School and at the back of the D.L. Umali Hall are reserved for Golden Jubilarians and guests. Participants will be guided by traffic officers and directional parking signs.

10. Vehicular traffic: Private vehicles-turn either left or right after the UPLB gate and follow traffic officers and directional signs. Public vehicles must turn right after the gate.

11. All participating organizations must submit a brief description (in Filipino) of their college/institution for the emcees to read as they approach the stage and guests gallery (front of D.L. Umali Hall). Length is limited to one page, double space, font size 16, Arial. Please email the description on or before **October 2, 2019, 5:00 pm** to **uplbloyaltyparade@gmail.com**.

12. The final sequence of participating organizations in the 2019 Loyalty Day Parade will be posted on the Loyalty Day event website (**loyaltyday.uplb.edu.ph**) on **October 9, 2019**.
